To improve pupils' resilience by raising self-esteem.	£10000	Gary Whitaker	Sports Premium funding was used to provide some cover for the PE coordinator to establish a wide range of extra-curricular activities. Students taking part in after school activities rose from approximately twenty five in 2015-16 to over 190 students participating in clubs each term during the 2016-17 school year. Clubs ranged from Parkour to Sewing Club to Ready Steady Cook.  Funding was used to ensure our children participated in inter-school fixtures against other local schools and within the Astrea group of schools. These fixtures helped build relationships and allowed students to build resilience and raise their self-esteem.  Time was used to prepare and implement bids to various companies to ensure that the school received extra funding to enhance the opportunities that our students enjoyed. These helped to provide breakfast, lunchtime and after-school clubs.  The mindfulness project made a positive start with children being interviewed to speak about their aspirations in sport. Unfortunately, due to unforeseen circumstances and classroom commitments, this project had to be put on hold in order to meet the needs of the students in the PE specialists' class.  New equipment was purchased in order for our students to receive the best possible experience in their Physical Education lessons and try out new sports.  As a school, we believe that the School Sports Premium Funding helped establish new opportunities for our students and helped some of our students find new sports and activities that they are now enjoying in their own time, meaning that it has had a lasting impact.
