Literacy

In Literacy this half term we will be focusing on introducing the elements of the Year 2 writing curriculum. The children will be focusing their writing around a range of novels, using these as inspiration for their creative writing. In reading, we will be looking at improving our prediction, summarising and inference skills.

Art/DT

Relating to our topic, Year two will be developing a wide range of art and design techniques in using pattern, colour, texture, line, shape, form and space. We will also be exploring and using different mechanisms.

PE

This half term, Year 2 will be focusing on how to move our bodies in different ways and how we can travel around the room in different directions and positions.

Computing

Using a range of ICT software, the children will start to look at simple programs and how they work. They will also start to look at how they can present their work on a computer.
