## Can you see...?

This activity can help your child practise listening carefully, learning new words and talking in sentences. The activities are linked to winter and the seasons.

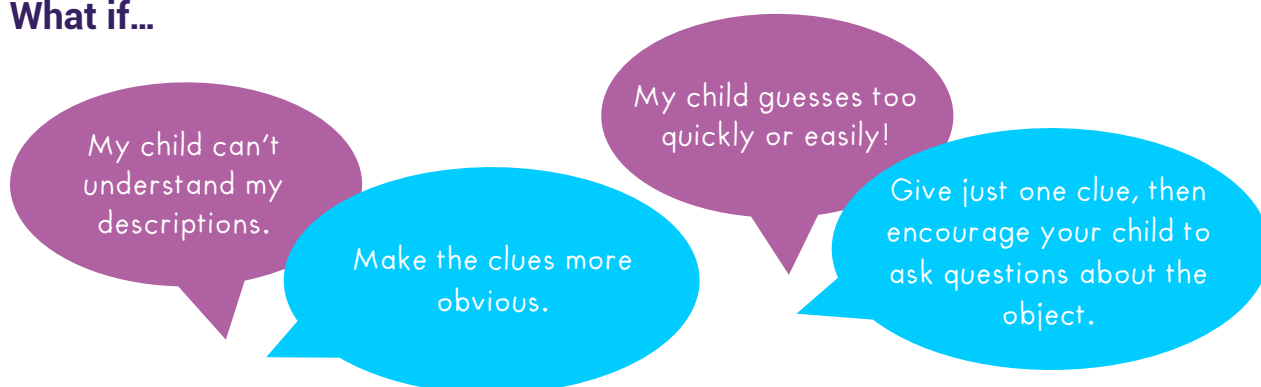
### Getting Ready

Use the picture and examples provided or think of your own ideas.

## Playing the game

- Look at the pictures, one of winter and one of spring. Talk about the differences between the different times of year and explain these are called seasons.
- Explain that you are going to describe something you can see on one of the pictures and they need to find what it is you are describing. Ask them if it is in the spring or winter.
- The idea of the game is to really get your child looking and thinking about what it could be that you are describing. Also, to talk about all the activities happening in the picture.
- **E.g.** “Can you find something very tall with snow on top?”
- Talk about what you can see and explain any words your child doesn’t understand. There are some unusual words and activities you could talk about and explain **e.g.** The mountains.
- We have given you some suggestions to get you started, though do use your own ideas.

## Taking it further!

- Swap roles, with your child giving the clues and you finding the object they are describing.
- Talk about the similarities and differences between these pictures and where you live, **e.g.** “We don’t have mountains, but we do have hills. We don’t have a skating pond.”
- Talk with your child about making a snowman. How would they make it? What would it look like? What would it be wearing? Encourage them to draw a picture of their best snowman with clothes and friends.
