MATHS


Number and Place Value

We are reading different scales of measure e.g. length, mass and capacity.

Home Task: get your child to measure the length of different objects using a ruler, the weight of objects using scales and the capacity of liquid using a measuring jug.

Times Tables

This week our focus is on the 8- and 9-times tables. **Encourage your child to chant these multiples wherever and whenever!**



WRITING

Narrative Opening

Our new class book is 'Odd and the Frost Giants'. We will use this text within our English lessons to inspire us to create our own setting descriptions through the use of descriptive language techniques.

Can your child write a character description using expanded noun phrases.

READING

Firework Maker's Daughter

Next week, we will begin reading The Firework Maker's Daughter. Children will develop their inference skills and use evidence from the text to support their answers.

Can your child make a prediction on what they think is going to happen in the story from reading the title and looking at the front cover?

Reading – our expectation is to read at least 3x per week at home.

Handwriting – this week we are learning f and g letters. Please practise these at home.
