

Year 6 Learning Leaflet

MATHS

Short multiplication.

We are using our 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9 times tables to solve short multiplication calculations! This will recap previous learning, so we will adding plenty of problem solving questions into our lessons.

Home Task: give your child a calculation (4678 x 8) and race them to see who can find the answer first.

342 x 7 becomes

$$\begin{array}{r} 342 \\ \times 7 \\ \hline 2394 \\ 21 \end{array}$$

Answer: 2394

2741 x 6 becomes

$$\begin{array}{r} 2741 \\ \times 6 \\ \hline 16446 \\ 42 \end{array}$$

Answer: 16 446

WRITING

Synonyms and Antonyms

We are starting a new unit of writing that focuses on the text, 'The Promise'. We will be writing balanced arguments by using synonyms and antonyms for the word 'promise'. Synonyms we will look at include; oath, agreement, vow, and commitment.
