MATHS

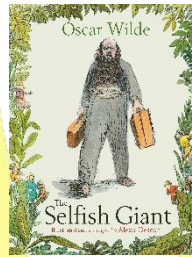
Multiply 2-digit numbers by 1-digit

Times Tables

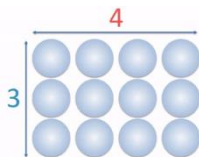
This week our focus is on the 4- and 8-times tables. **Encourage your child to chant these multiples wherever and whenever! They can also test themselves on sound check.**



WRITING

This week we will use the story *The Selfish Giant* to write our own narrative. Our focus is to build cohesion through the use of varied sentence types and fronted adverbials.

Can your child write a simple, compound and complex sentence about the selfish giant?



24 x 6 becomes

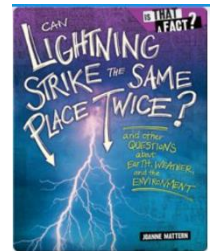
