MATHS Fractions


This week we will start looking at fractions! Particularly, we will be looking at how we simplify fractions before we move on to calculating with fractions. **Home Task: Ask your child if they can simplify 8/12 and explain how they did it.**

WRITING Write a Sequel

This week we will start a new unit of writing around the Diary of Anne Frank. We will look at adding question tags to our sentences to express how a someone may be feeling.

Alex is simplifying $\frac{8}{12}$ by dividing the numerator and denominator by their highest common factor.

Factors of 8: 1, 2, **4**, 8
Factors of 12: 1, 2, 3, **4**, 6, 12
4 is the highest common factor.


$$\frac{8}{12} = \frac{2}{3}$$
