

Year 6 Learning Leaflet

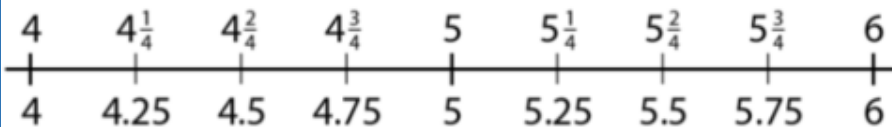
MATHS

Fractions, Decimals, percentages
This week in year 6 we will continue looking at finding decimals and percentages that are equivalent to fractions. We will also start looking at solving calculations involving algebra.
Home Task: Ask your child if they can tell you what the equivalent fraction of 3.75 is.

WRITING

Journalistic Writing

This week we will be planning and writing our own newspaper article on the Guardian article based around the story of the Three Little Pigs. We will particularly look at how to include witness and expert quotations in our writing.



READING

Texts on Fossils

Our texts this week will continue to focus on the theme of fossils. We will develop our summarising skills by summarising sections of text in three sentences or less.
