MATHS

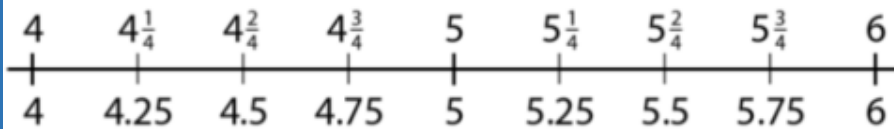
Fractions, Decimals, percentages

WRITING

Journalistic Writing
