Transition Information

Arrangements for the beginning and end of the day

- Doors will open at 8:45am and close at 9am. Registration in class will close at 9:05am.
- KS2 pupils can use either door on the Tudor Street playground to enter the building at the start of the day.
- Year 5 will leave via the green door (next to the Y5 trim trail).
- Year 5 are allowed to walk home if permission is given by a parent or carer. Please collect permission slips from school office.
- If your child is being collected by another adult, please inform the school office or a member of staff that works in your child's class.

Break times and dinner time

- Year 5 will receive a 15-minute break during the morning.
- During this time, they are allowed to eat a healthy snack brought from home (fruit or vegetable). Healthy snacks can be kept in drawers or bags until break time.
- There will be a range of games and equipment to help them burn off some steam. We also have the trim trial which they will be able to use on designated days and the Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) which is perfect for ball games.
- No ball or toys should be brought in from home.

Arrangements for PE

- Children will be taught 2 sessions of P.E. every week.
- PE days and arrangements will be confirmed shortly via Astrea App message.
- It is very important that your child brings the correct PE kit every week:
 - White T-shirt and black shorts
 - o Trainers or pumps for outdoor PE.
 - o Sports jumpers may be worn over a white T-shirt for outdoor PE if it is cold.
 - Earrings must be able to be independent removed by the child. Earrings are not allowed to be covered. Failure to remove them will mean pupils will not be able to take part in PE and parents/carers will be informed.

Water Bottles/milk

- So pupils stay hydrated, they are allowed to bring water bottles which they will have access to throughout the day. Please ensure that these are taken home regularly to be washed and filled with water only.
- Water bottles will be kept at the back of the room during the day.
- Milk is available for the children. Parents can find out the necessary payment details at the school office.

Homework

Children will be given a reading book which they are expected to read every night.
The more opportunities they have to read to an adult at home, the better readers they will become.



• Children will also be given weekly spelling and maths homework.

- There will be three opportunities over the year to meet with your child's class teacher to discuss their learning and progress in more detail. Please keep a look out for letters with more details closer to the time.
